

Rolling Pins

Rolling pins should be well floured when in use to prevent sticking. The Pin will require some break-in and reapplication of salad bowl wax or butcher block oil. This item is treated with Clapham's Salad Bowl Finish, a beeswax based product and the recommended finish for all unvarnished wood kitchen utensils.

Do not wash pins or put in dishwasher. Wipe with a damp cloth if necessary. Hard buildup can be removed with a dough divider or a damp scrubber if necessary; dry well and treat with salad bowl wax or butcher block oil. If damp wiping or humidity change causes portions of the wood grain to raise or fuzz, sand the area gently with 220 or 320 sandpaper and treat with salad bowl wax or butcher block oil.
